 - Reduce your responsibility under FOIA
 - Assure access to data held by the applicant
 - Provide you with a focal point and a team of resources

Corporate Information

- NOT normal business communication via e-mail. But, if you are exchanging any of the below data then you should read the Order and Guide and contact your local Focal Point:
- Restricted, technical or proprietary data including: Certification and Production Data or other information the applicant or approval holder shares with the FAA such as:
 - Technical Specifications
 - Process Specifications
 - Drawings
 - Test Reports
 - Analysis
