Subject: Grant of Deviation to Extend Effective Date of AD Manual, Revision C

The Airworthiness Directive (AD) Manual, FAA-IR-M-8040.1C, was issued on May 17, 2010, with an effective date of June 21, 2010. This memorandum grants a deviation to extend the effective date to August 20, 2010. This deviation is granted to provide time for the Assistant Chief Counsel for Regulations, AGC-200, to review and concur with the AD templates.

All AD worksheets (and subsequent drafting of the AD action from the worksheet) submitted to a directorate after August 20, 2010, must be in accordance with the AD Manual, FAA-IR-M-8040.1C. Note that an AD action currently in coordination is not required to comply with FAA-IR-M-8040.1C.
