*Limitations and Conditions* (Continued):

The MT Propeller Model MTV-15-B/205-58 propeller diameter limits are 80.7 to 79.7 inches. The minimum tire size is 8.50 x 6 inch with a minimum tire pressure of 25 psi. The max continuous power is limited to engine RPM of 2650. Instructions for Continued Airworthiness dated August 12, 2005 is required. Compatibility of this design change with previously approved modifications must be determined by the installer. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

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
